

CONSENT TO DISCLOSE TAX RETURN INFORMATION
CHASE BANK PRODUCTS

The First Advance Refund Anticipation Loan, Refund Anticipation Loan or Bonu\$ Deposit Account you have applied for is provided and serviced by JP Morgan Chase, N.A. ("Chase"). For the remainder of this document, the terms First Advance Refund Anticipation Loan, Refund Anticipation Loan and Bonu\$ Deposit Account will individually and collectively be referred to as the "Financial Product(s)".

To evaluate and process your application for a Financial Product chase requires a copy of your entire 2009 tax return ("2009 Tax Return"). Your 2009 Tax Return prepared by ("Tax Preparer") will be sent electronically to Pendleton and Goudy Tax Service ("Pendleton & Goudy") the electronic filing services provider for Tax Preparer. Without your 2009 Tax Return, Chase will not process your request for a Financial Product; however, Tax Preparer will still prepare your tax return if you so choose. If you sign this form and check the box below, you authorize Pendleton & Goudy to disclose your 2009 Tax Return for the designate purpose. Insert a checkmark in the corresponding box if you consent to the disclosure described.

If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year.
